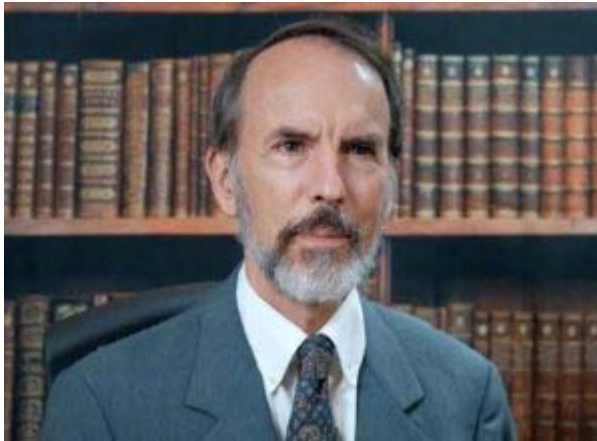

Mr. Owen is the convert son of Sir David Owen, a former secretary general of International Planned Parenthood Federation. Mr. Owen directs the Kolbe Center for the Study of Creation which provides a forum for Catholic theologians, philosophers, and natural scientists all over the world who defend the traditional Catholic doctrine of creation that was handed down from the Apostles and who are dedicated to making sure that the evidence for and against the evolutionary hypothesis is made available to Church leaders and to the lay faithful. Mr. Owen and his colleagues have participated in conferences on creation and evolution at major academic centers in Europe, including several conferences in Rome and a conference at Gustav Siewerth Akademie in Germany which received the explicit blessing and encouragement of Pope Benedict XVI.



Hugh gave a talk for us early last year on "The Traditional Catholic Doctrine of Creation: The Only Firm Foundation for a Culture of Life". He has presented his current topic in world-class academic forums including the Catholic Medical Association, the National Research Council in Rome, and Gustav Siewerth Akademie in Germany, the small Catholic university that then-Bishop Josef Ratzinger helped to establish before he became the head of the CDF.
